Following his initial introduction to Ginetta Junior racing in the 2018 Ginetta Junior Winter series at Brands Hatch where he won Rookie 1st place in Round 1 and finished 6th overall in the Championship, Roman and his Romski Racing team are all set to do well this year.

London born and raised in Gloucestershire, he is extremely proud of his Polish heritage and named his team, Romski Racing, after the nickname given to him by his family.

Like other kids of his age he enjoys playing x-box games, fishing, riding his segway and, when he can, skiing - anything but his homework. But that's where the similarities stop. Roman races cars. Fast cars and he's good at it too.

WINNING MENTALITY

At 14 Roman is one of the youngest drivers to compete in this exciting competition but he's already earned a reputation to race fast and fearless having won the 2017 Rissington Honda Cadet Championship in his first season and the Nigel Mansell 'Most Promising Driver' Award.

Roman's racing coach, Sennan Fielding, believes;

'He's a natural. He has 100% ability. And so competitive too - he just wants to win'.
